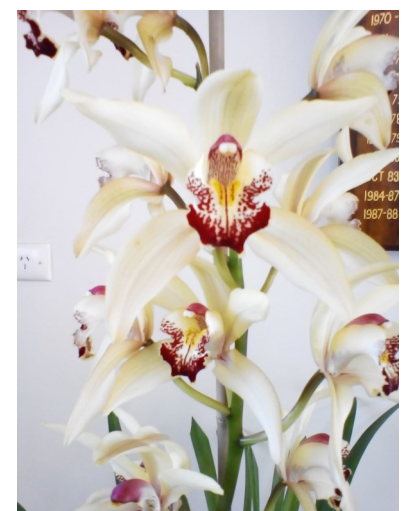
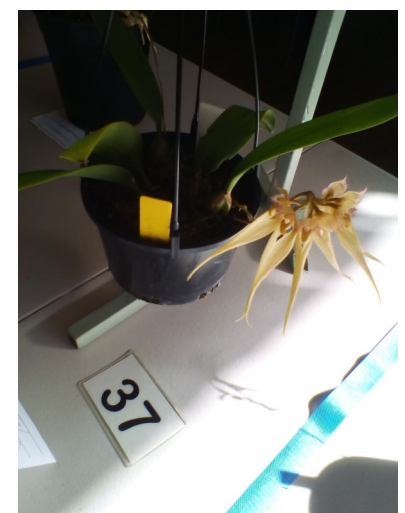
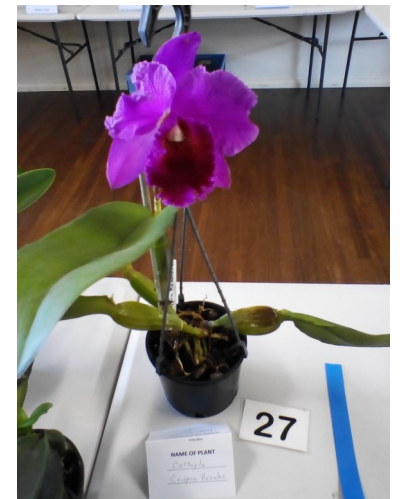

NOVICE CORNER BY A.M. & J.C.

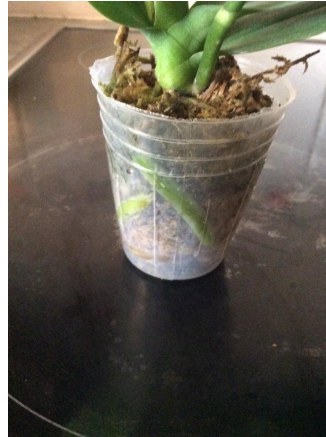
This month we are looking at “Re-potting a phalaenopsis. “ Part 1



GROW Orchids
TIPS FOR BEGINNERS



Sold in a glass this poor plant is drowning. With water already in the crown it will most likely rot. I wouldn't buy this.



Out of the glass. Already bottom roots in water have rotted. The pot is the first pot it was grown in and is too small. New root tips have terminated. This plant is already declining.



Squeezed into the glass damaged the leaves. This provides an entry point for bacteria and fungi that leads to crown rot, defoliation and death. Best to keep this plant crown dry at all times.



Flowers have faded.



I prefer clear pots. That way I monitor moisture levels and root condition.



Remove spike. I want growth, not flowers and forcing this to flower again will stress it further. Note where I cut the spike. Close to the plant.



Out of moss. Note rotten roots already. New roots have stopped growing. They should be active this time of year. [Summer]
