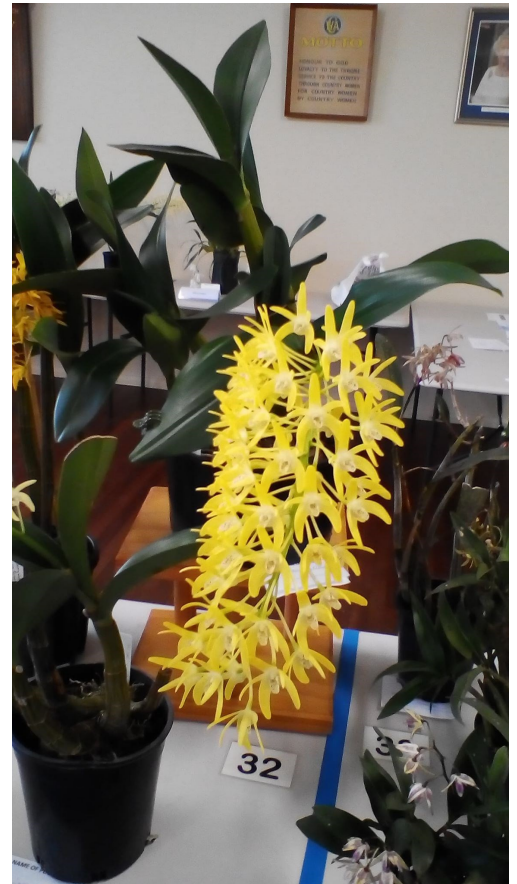

This month we are completing "Re-potting a phalaenopsis." Part 2



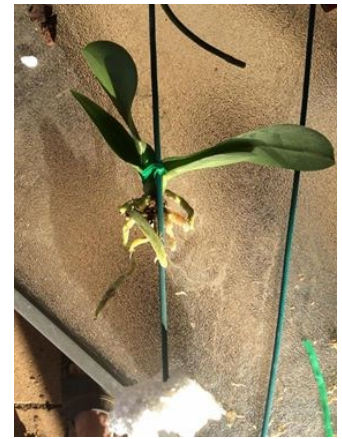
**GROW Orchids**  
TIPS FOR BEGINNERS



Moss removed. Note rotten and broken roots. The retailers treat these roughly.



Moss is only good for a year after that it becomes sour. This is 2 years old. Looks dull.



Broken and rotten roots trimmed. This plant is lucky I got to it in time. Some of you will have next to no roots if left too long. I stake my plants like this. The foam block gives my plant more stability to offset the poor root system.



Plant is centred.



A good quality orchid bark with a bit of perlite is all you need. Avoid packaged orchid mixes. They tend to water log the plant.



Potted. Note the height in the pot. Water in with seasol every week for the first three months.

NOTE: The disturbance of repotting should make it initiate new roots. The older roots can also start to regrow. The clear pot makes it easy to see if the plant needs watering and also what is happening underneath. This advice is general only and is aimed at growers who keep these as indoor plants.
