TIPS FOR BEGINNERS

Although as long as our orchids grow, flower and prosper, we are generally happy with what we have.



My place over the years has developed individual areas of convenience, - cymbidiums where they can stand upright, massies where they can be coolest, etc.



One of the convenient places is my driveway where my tinny is parked.

It started with—" I'll just put this plant here until I open the gate to move it." But they continued to rest there under the tinny.



Orchids need—sunshine, air flow, water, some where to be, fertiliser and to be appreciated.

Well my unusual orchid "house" must be doing something right, as I have orchids flowering and prospering.

One day they will be moved, but not just now, as other things in my life have priority. A.M.

P.s. Novices—do use what you have but always be on the lookout for up grades. :) - I need a bigger boat.



Our club orchid is the Cymbidium tracyanum.

One of the most sought after species, autumn to winter flowering, and with very attractive large flowers, Cymbidium tracyanum also has sweetly fragrant flowers.

The species itself is readily available. This is a cymbidium that is best grown as a specimen plant. The magnificent flowers deserve this amount of attention.

Both sepals and petals are slightly twisted and both are spotted and striped.

Being an epiphytic orchid, this is a species that requires excellent drainage. It is also from warmer climates, mainly Burma through to southern China. It grows naturally in strong filtered light and thrives on warm moist summer conditions.
