NOVICE CORNER

- helpful hints for novice growers.

Dendrobium SPECIOSUM



Many of our members grow these orchids locally and grow them very well. Apart from the time it takes for them to mature, to flowering size, they are an excellent orchid for the novice, but think BIG!! It is worth the money, to buy a medium to large size plant—to

see them flower.

They are hardy, tough, drought

resistant orchids with large spikes of many flowers. Even I currently have three in flower and another doing its best to join its friends.

This orchid is native to a vast section of Australia—ranging from Mallacoota [Victoria] to up past Cairns [QLD].



It can tolerate near frost, to temperatures over 45 degrees, without severe damage. They are even known to recover, [to various degrees of success], from bush fires.

This is an orchid that thrives on low to medium humidity, bright to very bright light and an open, well draining medium.

They grow naturally on granite cliff faces and on boulders in open, grassy paddocks. The plants grow into large specimens with, one, two or three spikes per cane.

[Den. Dunokayla] The key to mass flowering, seems to be, a very bright, open,

breezy position. A constantly moist root system is also important, as in natural cliff faces, they live on weep moisture constantly.



These bottom six photos are off the same name—Den Lochiel. The genetics behind this plant, gives rise to a wide variety of possible combinations. This can give different sizes, colours and shapes.
