#### **OVER THE BREAK.**

Over the break, keep an eye on your orchid house for those plants, that are not progressing.

The paling leaf, the chewed off aerial roots or the colour change in the bulbs, these are all warning signs of problems happening.

Check your orchid house at night and catch those grasshoppers or other night time predators.

Feel those bulbs for softness, which could be a sign of rot

Check the plant with the paling leaves— too little light, too light water or maybe too much light. Move them if needed—for light changes. Lifting and knowing how heavy they should be, will tell you of the water issues.

Don't put off that regular inspection over Christmas, your orchids need your attention and care.

Tidy up and rearrange, so you will have room for all the orchids, Santa will leave you, under the Christmas tree.
