NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SELLING OF PLANTS DIRECT TO THE PUBLIC.

The Milton Ulladulla Orchid Society Inc. (MUOS) holds a Grower Licence within the meaning of the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016. The conditions of this licence are set out in the publication by the Office of Environment and Heritage titled 'Protected Whole Plants Sustainable Management Plan 2018 – 2022', and as a result all members of MUOS must ensure they comply with the following –

A. Tagging of plants.

- 1. A 'grower tag' must be placed into the pot or attached to the pot of each plant.
- 2. Every 'grower tag' must contain the following information
 - a. The name of the organisation to which the member belongs. (ie MUOS)
 - b. The wording 'Plantation Grown' and
 - c. The word 'species' or 'hybrid' as the case may be, and the name of the plant.

To assist members comply with the above, MUOS will obtain printed tags so only the plant details in 'c' above will be required to be completed by the seller.

B. Other requirements.

- 1. "Bare rooted' plants may not be sold to the public.
- 2. Plants attached to an 'endemic growing media' (eg mounts) are also prohibited from sale, however should a member wish to do so, he/she would have to provide evidence (eg photographic), of their mounting practices, so as to avoid any possibility that the plant had been collected from the wild, and the grower will have to provide assurance to the President or a Nominee, that evidence exists that the mount onto which the plant is attached was not collected from the wild with the plant attached.

C. Record keeping.

MUOS is required to keep records of all plants sold to the public for a period of two years, and to make them available for inspection if requested to do so.

In order to comply with this, a 'Plant Sales Form' will be required to be completed by all sellers.

A sample of this form is attached to these notes.

The Committee suggests that prospective sellers complete these forms well in advance of show dates.

Sellers will need to get their plants **checked off** by an authorised Committee Member before the plants can be displayed on the sales tables.

- 1. All Plants must be well established, healthy, disease and pest free. The Show Marshal(s) or other authorised person, may refuse any plant considered unsaleable.
- 2. All Australian Native Species plants must be tagged in accordance with NPWS Regulations.

(MUOS is licenced and can provide Grower tags for sale at the sales table if needed).

Note that MUOS grower tags must have recorded on them: "MUOS" and "Plantation Grown" plus". the relevant orchid species or hybrid name) for Hybrids the word "Hybrid" must be recorded on the tag. Eg Den. Speciosum

- 3. All plants must be ticketed with the sellers' code, price and ticket number corresponding with the above.
- 4. MUOS will take all reasonable care and precautions, but will accept no liability for plants lost or stolen from the sales table.
