#### **Extract from Alan and Miriam's Newsletter**

Repotting of most genera can begin by this month DO NOT START TOO EARLY or divisions will have a big set back like "death" After repotting give plants a good soak with AUXINONE or you could use STIMU-LIZER to get your plants moving. DO NOT OVERWATER NEWLY POTTED PLANTS. MERRI COTE can be sprinkled around the top of the pots now. The above applies to most genera.

A New Sealant for Orchid Growers! As mentioned last newsletter a new wound sealant has hit the market PRUNE TEC® In the past we have been using all types of sealants to seal cuts on our orchids. Acrylic, bitumen based products etc. PRUNE TEC will callus at the wound to seal the cut. PRUNE TEC is made from an advanced polymer coating which gives a perfect seal so no fungicide is used in the formulation. The reason fungicides are added in other products is that they do not fully form a protection barrier and there is a greater chance of infection to the plant. For further information give me a ring 02 4739 5141, I hope to have a few samples for growers to try on divided plants.

For those who grow a lot of Sarcs. will have to watch the *botrytis* spotting. For those who have a programme for spraying and use MANCOZEB® in the programme will not have much problem with flower spotting. If spotting is a problem you may have to use IPPON® 500. Watch the pH of the spray water that you use. DO NOT USE IF Ph is 7 or higher. For further info give me a ring. At last the dendrobium beetles have arrived and what a mess they make to our flowers and bulbs! To keep them under control you can physically catch them by hand or spray with BUGMASTER® every four to six weeks. Don't forget to rug up in full protective clothing when using this insecticide. Some growers have used one of the oils such as ECO OIL®. Use at 5mls per litre of water, it will kill off two spotted mites at the same time. DO NOT SPRAY ONTO FLOWERS, BUDS as it can cause flower wilt.

Over the last few weeks some growers have started repotting. After a week or two, bulb rot has started to occur. This has been caused by dividing plants when too small into too big a pot, over watering, poor drainage by compost would not allow drainage after watering!! Too much sun, always go back to basics if you have a basic problem. Look at plants very carefully when repotting e.g. root rot – compost breakdown – soggy compost especially in bottom of pot. Check for insects, e.g. red spider, curl grubs in bottom of pot. Don't forget compost insects such as <u>fungus gnats</u>. If they are a problem drench with MUNNS LAWN GRUB KILLER available at Bunnings. After repotting don't forget to give plants a good soak with AUXINONE®. This will give the roots a good start. A sprinkle around the pot with MERRI COTE will gibe plants a kick along for the next few months. This is available here; TINONEE ORCHID NURSERY ROSELLA ORCHIDS AT GRAFTON AND EZI GROW ORCHIDS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIAN. For further information give me a ring regarding supply.

Now is the time to watch your shading Remember SUMMER is coming.

For all of you supplies give me a ring we still have supplies of Merri Fert, Merri Cote, Port pots Auxinone some chemicals compost.
