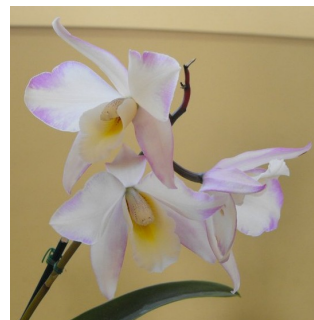

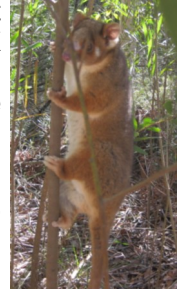

Well I have some news on what was eating my orchids. A week before the Spring Show I had so many orchids in bud, that I was thinking that I would have plenty for the Show only to go out one morning to find that a lot of the buds had been eaten once again, I knew then that it could not be insects or rats so it had to be a Possum. We set a trap up in the shadehouse and for the next week caught nothing (as I had removed anything that I thought maybe OK for the show) once the Show was over I pick some *Coelogyne cristata* and on the second night bingo we caught two ringtail possums at the same time and then three nights later we caught another one pictured here.



I was lucky enough to get a division of one of Ted Walmsley Speciosums plus a few other plants from the recent Speciosum Spectacular at Kempsey, so I will be looking forward to seeing these plants bloom.

It is now time to fertilizing and do some re-potting before summer.
